## GE ASSET MANAGEMENT VENTURE BUYS AHWATUKEE AREA APARTMENTS IN \$84 MILLION DEAL

Phoenix - A company formed by GE Asset Management Inc. in Stamford, Ct. and ChrisKen CK Property Management LLC in Chicago, III. (Jack Kennedy, pres.) paid \$84 million (\$172,131 per unit) to acquire the 488-unit San Melia apartments located within the Ahwatukee area of Phoenix at 14435 S. 48th Street. The seller was AIMCO San Melia LLC, formed by AIMCO in Denver, Colo. (Terry Considine, CEO). The deal was negotiated through Cindy Cooke and Brad Cooke of Colliers International in Phoenix. Maricopa County records show San Melia PT LLC (GE/ChrisKen entity) acquired the property with a \$46.2 million Fannie Mae loan issued through CBRE Multifamily Capital Inc. The luxury rental community was developed in 1998 by Mark-Taylor Inc. of Scottsdale. GE Asset Management (GEAM) is the money management arm of General Electric Co. (NYSE:GE). As of June 30, GEAM had \$115 billion in assets under its management, of which \$17 billion was third-party assets. ChrisKen serves as a consultant and operating partner to GEAM, which is the real estate advisor to the General Electric Pension Fund. In September, General Electric Co. announced it is exploring options to sell GEAM and could have buyer identified by first quarter 2016. San Melia is the second apartment asset BREW has reported ChrisKen and GE Asset Management purchasing in the Valley. In June 2012, BREW reported GEAM/ChrisKen paying \$45.6 million (\$132,857 per unit) to acquire the 350-unit La Privada apartments at 10255 E. Via Linda in Scottsdale. ChrisKen, which serves as an advisor to institutional clients and private investors, is looking for more apartment investment opportunities in the Phoenix area.
